



Moorpark Girls Softball All Stars Process

8.0 ALL-STAR MANAGER SELECTION:

An All-Star manager candidate must be a coach during the spring season to be eligible. Managers must apply to be All Star Managers through the MGS online application. Late entries will not be considered unless there is a shortage of managers for the division. The All Star Committee will thoroughly review each potential manager and any relevant information. Potential All Star managers must receive approval by a majority vote of the All-Star Committee. The Committee comprises the President, Vice President, Director of Coaches, Player Agent, Division Commissioner, and All Star Coordinator. The Secretary will be present but will not participate in voting. The Committee will conduct interviews with Managers to determine the best fit. The All Star Committee will rank the coaches, and the Secretary will maintain this ranking for reference during the All Star Draft.

If a manager is selected to lead the Gold All-Star team but their daughter is not ranked within the top 10 players, that manager becomes ineligible, and the next highest ranked manager would be considered for the Gold team (provided their daughter is ranked among the top 10 players).

8.1 NUMBER OF ALL-STAR TEAMS:

Moorpark Girls Softball aims to field at least 2 All-Star teams in the 6U, 8U, 10U, and 12U divisions, with the potential for a third, bronze team if there is sufficient interest. 6U Teams will always be as balanced as possible. The Board of Directors retains the right to adjust the number of teams annually based on division registration.

8.2 ALL-STAR SELECTION PROCESS:

8.2.A Each team must consist of 11 players, with a 12th player being optional at the manager's discretion.

8.2.B Parents of any player wishing to participate in All-Stars must complete and sign the All-Star Parent/Player Contract and provide a check payable to MGS for \$200 for their All-



Star Tournament Snack Bar Deposit and Field Maintenance Duties. This contract and payment must be submitted to MGS by the specified due date set by the league.

8.2.C All-Star Draft for all divisions: Spring managers (including Select Coaches) from each division will convene in an open forum with the All Star Committee to discuss and select the All-Star teams. The Secretary will be present but will not vote.

The Gold team will consist of the top 10 players as ranked by the spring managers and the All Star Committee. Managers must consider player availability for scheduled tournaments, as indicated on the interest forms. The Gold manager will select any remaining player(s) from the list of interested players.

The Silver team will comprise the next highest ranked 10 players as selected during the All Star draft, with the Silver manager choosing any remaining player(s) from the pool of interested players.

This process will continue for divisions with a Bronze team.

Any player who declines their invitation to the All-Star team they were selected for will be ineligible for the following season of All Stars and Select. We strongly encourage players who have participated in the REC Spring season to join the All-Star postseason in their respective division. Players not selected for the GOLD Team in the upper division will be evaluated for teams in their respective division to ensure competitive teams in each division.

Teams will be announced via yard signs, email, and our website on May 2nd. Attendance at a mandatory parent meeting is required. (Note: Dates are subject to change to align with the USA Softball Yellow Book.)

8.4 TOURNAMENTS:

When tournament registration opens for invitationals, the All Star Director will pre-register teams for all divisions. All-Star player registration fees will reimburse the league for tournament fees and uniform deposits. The All-Star season officially ends when teams become disqualified from USA Softball Tournaments (i.e., Districts, States, Nationals/Regionals).



8.5 PLAYER EXPECTATIONS AND ADDITIONAL FEES:

8.5.A Players are required to attend all practices and games, unless otherwise specified in the interest form prior to team selection. Additionally, managers reserve the right to remove players from the team if they do not attend practices.

8.5.B All-Star coaches may request additional funds to be spent during the season, such as add'l tournaments, matching batting helmets, player bags, sweatshirts/jackets, swag bags, etc.

8.6 STATE & NATIONAL QUALIFICATION:

Teams that qualify for USA Softball State or National Tournaments must participate in those tournaments.

8.7 USA Softball RULES:

USA Softball Rules take precedence over MGS Local Rules during All-Star play.
